



GratitudeAmerica Warrior PATHH Guide

Job Summary:

The PATHH Guides of GratitudeAmerica Inc. Warrior PATHH, are responsible to the Program Director for the planning, preparation, and coordination of PATHH programs focused on cultivating and facilitating Posttraumatic Growth for combat veterans who are struggling with PTSD, combat stress, anxiety, depression, and suicidality. Through hands on interaction with program participants, PATHH Guides train participants to transform times of deep struggle into profound strength and lifelong growth and live the great lives they deserve full of passion, purpose, growth, and service.

Summary of essential job functions

- Participate in all Warrior PATHH programs (estimate 1 per month), which will require staying at the retreat up to eight days during programs.
- Become trained, certified and proficient as a PATHH Guide and accompanying activities, including kayaking, hiking, archery, equine activities, TRX, and module delivery.
- Participate in all GratitudeAmerica Inc. training programs as well as professional development.
- Ensure quality reception, support, and experience for all program participants at GratitudeAmerica Warrior PATHH (GAWP)
- Perform functional duties as assigned (this could include recruiting for PATHH programs, support with survey collection, alumni outreach, support for the Warrior PATHH Coaching programs)
- Ensure participant information is added to alumni database to maintain contact through 18-month program
- OUTREACH - Building connections and opportunities with families, businesses, financial partners, etc. Your main responsibilities will be reaching out to community and other organizations that support combat veterans in reintegration and wellbeing. Corresponding to emails and phone calls. Organizing meetings, events, and seeking out opportunities to make our organization's presence known. Collaborate with our Veteran Engagement Director about case eligibility.
- Participate in all Program, Staff and Management meetings as scheduled.
- Live GratitudeAmerica Inc. and PATHH Guide non-negotiable practices and principles at all times

Minimum requirements

The PATHH Guide must be a combat veteran and possess an education and professional background commensurate with this position. The PATHH Guide will typically have a bachelor's degree or equivalent, or have served in military leadership positions with 10-15 years (plus) experience.



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Physical Demands

While performing the duties of this job, PATHH Guides are regularly required to sit, stand, walk, speak, and hear. The position also requires spending a lot of time outdoors. The employee must frequently lift and/or move up to 50 pounds. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable otherwise qualified individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

Travel

PATHH Guides must be able to travel to get back and forth to work and run errands in and around Alachua, Florida (within 100 miles). A driver's license and a good driving record are required to use company vehicles.

Work Environment

The work environment is a small, busy facility located in Alachua, FL. The noise level in the work environment is usually low to moderate. Reasonable accommodations in the work environment may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
